Undocumented Immigrant Student (AB540)	<p>The AB540 law was passed in 2001 in order to allow undocumented students to pay resident fees in California's public colleges and universities, as long as the student graduates from a California high school with at least three years of residency in the state.</p> <p><u>AB540 Students must meet the following requirements:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school attendance in California for three or more years. • Graduation from a California high school or attainment of the equivalent, such as a GED. • Register as an entering student at, or current enrollment at, an accredited institution of higher education in California: University of California, California State University, and all community colleges. • If the person is without a lawful immigration status, the student must complete an affidavit with the public college or university stating that the student has filed an application to legalize his or her immigration status, or will file an application as soon as he or she is eligible to do so. • Student information provided to the college or university is confidential and protected by federal law.
